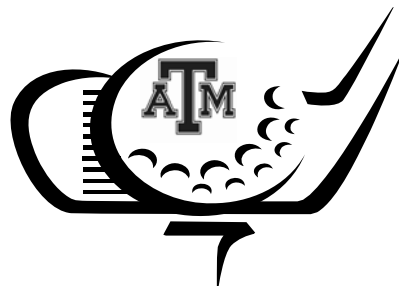

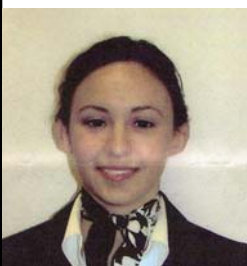
The Texas A&M University Career Center offers a variety of educational and employment services designed to assist Aggies every step of the way as they explore career options and make their decisions for the future. These efforts consist of Career Education activities, Experiential Education programs, Interview Services, even services for Former Students. Career Education efforts include workshops on key topics and job search skills, online self-assessment, career management courses for academic credit, advising services, and a resource library with the latest information on workforce trends. Experiential Education programs assist students with obtaining cooperative education and internship assignments. Interview Services includes on-campus interviewing, on-line job listings, and resume referral services. Our Former Student service provides advising and networking opportunities for Aggies who have been displaced in the job market or who are seeking to change occupations.

Many students fail to utilize these services in a timely fashion and here is where you can help. Aggie Moms can have a great motivational influence in encouraging their sons and daughters to prepare for the future job market. Students preparing to graduate and enter the job market this May as well as August 2007 should register now with the Career Center to participate in on-campus interviews, receive resume referral services, and gain access to job listings. Juniors, sophomores, and freshmen will benefit from career exploration services and experiential education programs.
