

# SAN ANTONIO AGGIE MOMS' CLUB SCHOLARSHIPS FOR CORPS OF CADET STUDENTS



The San Antonio Aggie Mothers' Club awards 3 scholarships to Corps of Cadets Students. These are classified as "Sul Ross Scholarships" and are granted for a total of \$2400 payable at \$600 per semester for four semesters of your freshman and sophomore years. Candidates are selected on excellent academic performance and demonstrated leadership.

To be eligible you must meet the following criteria:

- ∞ Be a Texas A&M incoming freshman, joining the Corps of Cadets
- ∞ Be a resident of Bexar County, Texas
- ∞ Have and maintain 2.5 GPR
- ∞ Be classified as a Full-time Student in Good Standing

## When to Apply

High school students should apply during their senior year in high school. Applying early will increase your chance to receive a Corps scholarship. Early selection may enable scholarship presentations to be made in the spring, usually during high school awards ceremonies.
