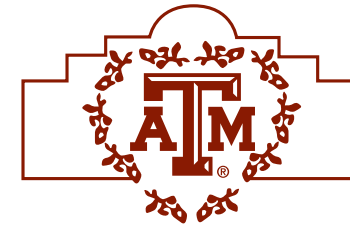

Who Are San Antonio Aggie Moms

We are part of a huge loving family of 126 clubs, officially called The Federation of Texas A&M University Mothers' Clubs. The groups band together for the benefit of the A&M student body. The San Antonio club was formed in 1926. This is the place where you can enjoy Aggie Mom fellowship, learn what is available for our students at A&M, how to encourage your student and help them be successful at A&M, and have fun raising funds for scholarships and student activities.

What We Do

Scholarships Over the years, the San Antonio Club has raised more than \$300,000 for scholarships and other student activities. In 2010, we are awarding \$18,450. We fund these scholarships through the selling of our merchandise, events and raffles, held throughout the years by our club. San Antonio Aggie Moms' is one of the leading Mothers' clubs in funding A&M student scholarships. Bexar County students apply for our scholarships through Texas A&M's financial aid department. Aggie Moms' raise the money and set the criteria; A&M officials select the recipients.

Student Support "Goodie" bags, are provided FREE to our Bexar County A&M students before exams during the Fall and Spring semesters. Watch the San Antonio Aggie Moms website and alert your student about the date and time.

Howdy Night held in midsummer to honor new, transfer students and their parents. It is the official "kickoff" of the new year for the San Antonio Aggie Moms Club. The celebration includes dining on "Bevo" Burgers and meeting Yell Leaders and other outstanding student representatives of the University.

Membership We invite anyone who wishes to support our Texas A&M University students, including those at the branch campus in Galveston to join us. Membership forms are available for download on our website. Send the annual dues of \$30 with your completed membership form to the address provided. Included with membership dues is a monthly newsletter and directory of current members. Periodic emails are sent as a reminder of meetings and special events. Membership must be renewed annually to remain on our mailing list and stay informed about activities. An additional family member may join for \$2 each. Associate members can pay \$10 to be included in the directory/yearbook but associate members do not receive newsletters. You automatically become a member in the Federation of TAMU Mothers' clubs.
